# RECENT GRANTS SECURED by Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation

Without the generous support of foundations, many outreach programs initiated by Good Samaritan Hospital would not be possible. Recently Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation was awarded the following grants and we want to recognize and thank the foundations for their support of programs and projects that improve the quality of life for the people living in our community.



## CATHOLIC HEALTH INITIATIVES MISSION AND MINISTRY FUND

Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation has been awarded a \$200,000 grant for Helping Opiate-Addicted Pregnant Women Evolve (HOPE) program. The project is designed to improve the maternal health and infant birth outcomes for opiate-addicted women.



## THE HELEN C. COARD FOUNDATION, PNC BANK, TRUSTEE

This foundation was established by Helen C. Coard who was a volunteer for many years at Good Samaritan Hospital. This foundation's most recent gift of \$12,000 is being used to award scholarships to students enrolled at the Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Science.

## THE CHARLES E. SCHELL FOUNDATION, FIFTH THIRD BANK, TRUSTEE

Generously, this foundation awarded \$100,000 payable over four years to provide educational assistance loans to nursing students enrolled at the Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Science. This loan program will allow students to fulfill their dreams of becoming a registered nurse.



## MARCH OF DIMES OHIO CHAPTER

Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation received a \$35,000 grant from the March of Dimes Ohio Chapter for the Helping Opiate-Addicted Pregnant Women Evolve (HOPE) program. Good Samaritan Hospital seeks to develop a model for postpartum care planning that ensures compliance with postpartum care and adherence to opioid addiction recovery and improves disease management and wellness support.



## SC MINISTRY FOUNDATION

Two grants have been provided to Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation by the SC Ministry Foundation.

- Summer Youth Employment Program

This grant provides fulltime summer employment at Good Samaritan Hospital/TriHealth for teens from Seton High School interested in pursuing a health care related career. Participants earn a competitive wage and have the opportunity to explore careers in health care.



- Good Samaritan Free Health Center

This grant was designated for Improving the Oral Health Status of the Good Samaritan Free Health Center Patients. The goal is to build upon the trust established within the Center for providing volunteer based care at no charge for those in need who do not have access. Attention will be focused on building a pattern for return visits for dental care, cleaning and education as appropriate.

# *Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation Donors Contribute \$1.3 Million to Help Fund New Cancer Center*

On Monday, June 2, 2014, a ribbon cutting ceremony was held for the TriHealth Cancer Institute at Good Samaritan Hospital. Donors, community leaders and board members were invited to participate in the dedication. The new Cancer Center officially opened on June 9, 2014 giving patients convenient and complete access to everything they need for their treatment in a comforting environment. The Cancer Center is located on the fourth floor of Good Samaritan Hospital, adjacent to the conference center. It provides patients access to their physicians, infusion and radiation treatment, an onsite laboratory, pharmacy and other services, including genetic counseling and help from social workers and care navigators.

Because infusion treatments often take four to five hours, special attention was given to the design of the infusion bays, which offer individual control of lighting, TV, heating and air conditioning. Each bay includes charging ports, WIFI, space for belonging and most importantly, room for family and friends. We would like to once again thank all of our donors for their support. Lead gifts from the Jacob G. Schmidlapp Trusts, Fifth Third Bank Trustees along with unrestricted dollars from Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation Trustees made this renovation project possible.

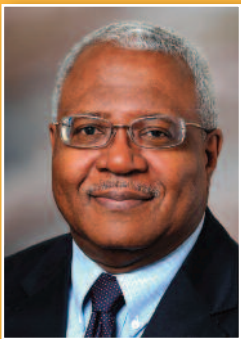

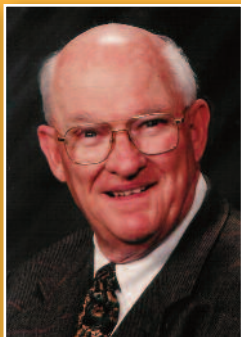

## A crystal clear passion for giving

ONE BRIEF conversation and you'd know. Even if he weren't Chairman of the Foundation's Board of Trustees, Mike Michael would still make sizable contributions to the Foundation. His passion is crystal clear.

## A gift to honor dad and his Good Sam caregivers

**HOW DO YOU HONOR** the life of your beloved father and the hospital that provided exemplary care during his final days? That was the challenge for Ginny Ruehlmann Wiltse and her husband, pulmonary and critical care physician David Wiltse MD.

In March 2013 Ginny's father, former mayor of Cincinnati Eugene Ruehlmann, gave the keynote address at a Western Hills High School alumni gathering. He talked about one of his favorite subjects, the importance of teamwork. "He did a great job," Ginny recalls, which is why the family was stunned days later to learn he had half a dozen abscesses in his brain.

The following months were a merry-go-round of treatment in and out of Good Samaritan. Ginny describes the hospital staff as incredibly caring and kind. She recalls how staff accommodated a steady stream of visitors, including Eugene's large family – children, their spouses, grand – and great grand – children, as well as the numerous friends you'd expect a popular former Cincinnati Mayor to accumulate during his 88 years.



From calling him "Mr. Mayor" to finding space in his room for his beloved jigsaw puzzles, the support of hospital staff extended across the continuum, from physician residents, nurses, respiratory therapists, chaplain. "No one could have had a more supportive group of people at their side," she adds.

After his death in June 2013, Ginny wanted to find a way to recognize hospital staff. She also wanted to honor the expert care her husband Dave provided to her father. "My parents refused to go to anyone but Dave; I don't think they realized the emotional toll that this would take on him," she says. During Eugene's eulogy,

son Mark noted that 'heroic' didn't adequately describe Dave's efforts to provide excellent care over the years.

Establishing the Eugene P. Ruehlmann Fund for Medical Education is a way for Ginny and Dave "to acknowledge the excellent care that Dad received at Good Sam," says Ginny. "Dave is a passionate teacher, and he believes strongly in the importance of continuing medical education," she says. "We hope our gift provides educational opportunities for hospital staff that will result in a continuation of the superb and compassionate care that my dad and my family received at Good Sam."

**"Everyone was so kind and considerate. A patient like Dad who was the ultimate gentleman – appreciative, courteous, and optimistic – engages the hospital staff in a positive way. So there develops a mutual regard, each of the other, and a sense that we are partners on a team with a common goal,"**  
Ginny keenly explains.

## Returning God's blessings – a reason to be generous



A **SERIOUS** motorcycle accident almost 40 years ago has left an impact on Jan Beckemeyer's entire life. Yet not in the way you might expect.

"They didn't think I'd make it," she says of the Emergency Room staff who cared for her immediately after the accident. "A priest gave me last rites." At the time Jan says she was a very independent yet immature 23-year-old. "Lying in a hospital bed for the next five months caused me to take a hard look at myself." In rehab she watched dozens of patients who would never walk again.

### "I started searching for reasons why God spared me."

For the next two decades Jan worked at Proctor & Gamble while undergoing multiple surgeries --she's had 35 since the accident, in Cincinnati, Houston and Baltimore. When she left the job in 1994, she knew it was time to start giving back to the people who helped spare her life. "I thought, shame on me if I can't return the blessings that God gave me."

Her gratitude journey began by volunteering in Good Sam's surgical waiting area. When one of the surgeons suggested she consider a new career in the OR, Jan says it was like being bitten by a bug. "One day I was invited to observe a surgery, and the next week I was back in school learning to become a surgical technologist." At age 47, Jan said the work fascinated her. "It was the coolest thing I've ever done." She showed her gratitude by donating her 3-day-a-week salary back to the OR "as a retroactive thank you to the staff for all they do for surgical patients."

Jan retired after 12 years when it became too difficult to stand for long periods. "Within days Mary Rafferty, President and Chief Executive Officer of Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation, introduced me to Linda Smith Berry, director of the Good Samaritan Free Health Center, and a bug bit me again," she laughs.

Now the Center's Volunteer Coordinator, Jan recruits doctors, dentists, nurses, hygienists, interpreters, community health workers and others who voluntarily keep the center running. Although a grant has paid the salary for this position for the last two years, Jan has donated her entire salary back to the center where it has been used to upgrade security and purchase much-needed equipment. Her enthusiasm for her job is infectious. "This place has blossomed; the work has been so incredibly rewarding to me!"

Jan has no plans to retire (although a new granddaughter means she'll work fewer hours). But when and if retirement occurs, she's made sure her generosity will remain. Gifts to the Free Health Center are included in her annual giving plan and in her will.

Humbled by all of her blessings, Jan graciously shares her story in the hopes it will move others to consider their blessings and to be generous too.





**“It is time to pass it on”**

**FIFTY YEARS AGO** Dr. Ranjit Rath was greeted at the front steps of Good Samaritan Hospital by Sister Marie Fidelis, SC. He had just arrived in the U.S. from his home in India to train as a surgeon. “As Sister showed me the way to the resident’s dormitory, she kindly explained what to expect in the next few years,” Dr. Rath remembers. “Here I found my family away from home within the compassionate surroundings provided by the Sisters of Charity.”

For the next five years Dr. Rath trained at Good Samaritan Hospital to be a surgeon. After an additional two-year fellowship at Yale University, he returned to the hospital that he loved and spent many years working with John Cranley MD, chief of surgery, who Dr. Rath warmly describes as being “like the father I left in India.” Dr. Rath spent his entire working career at Good Samaritan. It was the place where he met his wife Mary, a graduate of the Good Samaritan School of Nursing and it was the place where the couple’s premature triplet grandchildren

lived for their first 100 days. This year they are entering high school. Dr. Rath points out that “our affiliation with Good Samaritan began when we were young adults and we stayed all the way to retirement.” Throughout his career as a noted cardiac surgeon, he was instrumental in developing the hospital’s cardiothoracic surgery department. Now retired, he and Mary show their gratitude through sizable donations to the Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation, including the Good Samaritan Free Health Center where Mary was a longtime volunteer nurse. “We support the Health Center because Mary and I both strongly believe in the words of Matthew 25:35:”

**“For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in...”**

The couple’s generosity goes well beyond the Free Health Center. They also support the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and the Residency Training Program. They funded televisions for each of the thirty-two pre-operative holding

rooms, and they also donated DVD players for every room on the high risk maternity floor where expectant mothers stay before delivery, sometimes for weeks. Dr. Rath explains “the diversion helps to distract the mothers and possibly overcome their worries.” He came to realize the merits of this when both of his daughters spent time there before delivery. First, the daughter with the triplets, and later with his second daughter who stayed there because of a high risk twin pregnancy. Her two boys are also healthy, now entering fifth grade.

Helping others was instilled in Dr. Rath at a young age. His parents were his role models, supporting the education of multiple village children in India. “When I was young I had very little funds but many people supported me,” Dr. Rath explains. “It is time to pass it on.” Now retired, Dr. Rath still attends weekly educational conferences at the hospital “where I feel I am able to share my years of experience with the younger physicians and residents.”



## Happy to return the favor

**GRATITUDE** for our many blessings is the sentiment that drives Gene and Ann McCarthy. They show their gratitude with donations to the Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation.

The couple's connections to the hospital run deep, beginning in the early 1900s when Gene's father became Good Samaritan's first radiologist. At the same time, both Gene and Ann's mothers attended the hospital's School of Nursing. Ann's mom began her nursing career at Good Sam.

The hospital is the birthplace for the entire McCarthy family including Gene, Ann and their three children. They are grateful that Good Sam provided Gene the opportunity to work alongside his father as a radiologist. Although Ann spent her career teaching grade schoolers

and counseling high schoolers, she joined the fold after retirement when she became an active member of The Good Samaritans, and took her turn serving on the Board.

**"We have so many great friends that we met through Good Sam," says Ann. "They are good people; it's a good place." Gene adds, "We are grateful for all the hospital has provided us."**

It is this gratitude that motivates the couple to continually donate to "some very worthwhile causes," says Gene. The decision is easy "because they do such great work," he says of the hospital staff.

They specifically admire the quality, cutting-edge care that the hospital provides, and the attention to patient satisfaction at every turn. "We know

how devastating cancer can be," says Ann, "and admire that the Cancer Center provides patients all their caregivers together in one place. We think that's the way to go."

"Good Sam is always ready to provide expert care whether a patient can afford to pay or not," explains Gene when describing reasons he is grateful. He especially appreciates the hospital's investment in the daVinci Robotic Surgical System. "It is so beneficial to the patient," he says.
