Requirements

2. Submission of current high school transcript or most recent grade transcript from school currently attending or previously attended.
3. Receipt of three letters of reference, on behalf of the applicant, by the Scholarship Committee by April 1, 2024.
4. Receipt of letter of acceptance from school with accredited program by the Scholarship Committee by April 1, 2024.
5. Submission of a 500-word personal essay/statement of financial need, goals, personal qualities and/or experience.
6. Residence in Hospital Service Area of Butler, Preble, and Warren Counties in Ohio and Union, Franklin, Fayette, Dearborn and Wayne Counties in Indiana.
