

Hospital Auxiliary Clinical Health Professions Scholarship

The Auxiliary of McCullough-Hyde Memorial Hospital | Tri-Health is offering financial assistance to individuals preparing to work toward an accredited undergraduate degree in a clinical health discipline.

Our primary objective is to provide scholarships to candidates in our hospital service area who demonstrate the potential to succeed in a clinical health profession.

The award for each of the three scholarships for the 2026-27 school year is \$3000. The scholarships are funded in part by gifts sent to the Auxiliary in memory of, or in honor of, designated individuals.

Criteria for the scholarships is stated below:

1. Completion and submission of the scholarship form by April 1, 2026.
2. Submission of current high school transcript or most recent grade transcript from school currently attending or previously attended.
3. Three letters of reference, on behalf of the applicant, to the Scholarship Committee no later than April 1, 2026.
4. Letter of acceptance from school with accredited clinical health program, forwarded to Scholarship Committee by April 1, 2026.
5. Inclusion of personal a 500-word essay / statement of financial need, goals, personal qualities and/or experience.

Recipients will be selected based upon the following criteria:

- Completed Application / School Acceptance Letter / Letters of Reference
- Grade Point Average / Rank in Class / Test Scores (ACT—SAT) or GED
- Essay: Motivation, goals, financial need
- Leadership ability (*Motivation and leadership ability will be evaluated from essay and references.*)
- Residency in hospital service area of Butler, Preble, and Warren Counties in Ohio and Union, Franklin, Fayette, Dearborn and Wayne Counties in Indiana.
