Breasts are made of fat and glands held together by fibrous tissue. The more glands and fibrous tissue, the denser the breast tissue.



Dense breasts are normal. In fact, almost half of all women over 40 have dense breasts.

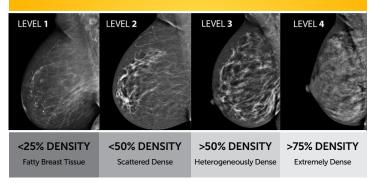


Dense breasts are a risk factor for cancer.



Dense breasts make it harder for radiologists to see early-stage cancer on a mammogram.
