

A Letter to Parents: Why We Believe in Vaccines—and Hope You Will Too

Increasingly more parents are worried or unsure about vaccines. Many ask us questions they read online, or share concerns they've heard from friends. We understand—every parent wants the best for their child, and it can be hard to know what information is right.

But from years of training, careful review of scientific evidence, and firsthand experience caring for children affected by vaccine-preventable diseases, we know that vaccines are one of the best ways to keep your child healthy and safe. Let's talk about why...

- **A Shield of Protection:** Vaccines act like a shield. They train your child's immune system to fight off diseases—like measles, mumps, polio, or tetanus—with your child getting really sick. If your child ever faces these diseases, their body will know how to defend itself. Before vaccines, diseases like polio and measles hurt or killed many children. Now, because of vaccines, these diseases are rare in countries like ours. That's how we know vaccines work.
- **Protecting Others Through Community Immunity:** Vaccinating your child helps not just your family but your whole community. When most people have vaccines, it's called "community immunity." This protects people who can't get vaccines, like babies or kids with certain health problems. Choosing vaccines helps keep everyone safe.
- **Vaccine Safety:** Some parents worry about vaccine safety, but vaccines are tested very carefully. Most side effects are mild, like a sore arm or a slight fever, and go away quickly. Serious side effects are very rare. Every recommendation we make for your child, including vaccinations, is based on the highest standards of safety and efficacy.
