Check Symptoms Anytime with MyChart!

Not sure whether your child needs a visit or just rest at home? **MyChart Symptom Checker** helps you quickly get answers based on your child's symptoms—anytime, day or night.

It's a simple tool that guides you through questions and suggests next steps such as home care, scheduling a visit, or sending a message to your care team.

With 20 common symptoms (10 just added!) available through Symptom Checker and the ability to schedule same day/next day visits, we're committed to making your child's care more convenient and connected!

What is DAX Copilot?

A new technology being used across TriHealth that allows your provider to focus more on you and less on the computer.

- DAX records the conversation between you and your provider, converts it into a medical note, and uploads it to your child's medical record. All notes are reviewed for accuracy.
- Your recorded visit is securely held and not accessed by anyone during transcription. If our partnership with DAX ends, your information will be de-identified or destroyed within 90 days.
- At your next visit, you may be asked to sign a DAX consent form which is valid for one year.
