#### Stay Safe This Season!

Back to school, cooler weather, the smell of pumpkin spice in the air...yes, it is almost flu season! As people spend more time indoors, viruses spread more easily. Here's a quick guide to help you keep your loved ones safe and healthy this season.

	Symptoms	What Should I Do?	When To Call the Doctor?
Colds	Runny nose, scratchy throat, low- grade fever, fatigue, sneezing, coughing and nasal congestion.	<ul> <li>There is no cure, only symptom management.</li> <li>Rest and stay hydrated.</li> <li>Colds can last a few days to several weeks.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Your scratchy throat lasts longer than a few days.</li> <li>You have trouble breathing or worsening symptoms.</li> </ul>
Flu/COVID	<ul> <li>Fever, body aches, sneezing, coughing, sore throat, headaches, runny nose.</li> <li>Loss of smell or taste, diarrhea and/or vomiting may also be present.</li> </ul>	Stay home and stay hydrated.     Once fever free for 24 hours and feeling better, you can return to school/work.	Symptoms last longer than a few days.     You have trouble breathing or worsening symptoms.
Strep Throat	Sore throat, stomachache, headache, fatigue, fever.	Strep is a bacterial infection that needs to be treated with antibiotics.	Call your primary care office for further advice and instruction.

**Seasonal Vaccines** can greatly reduce the risk of severe illness, missed work/school and hospitalizations. Contact your child's primary care provider to **schedule today!** 

#### Flu Vaccine (available October-February)

- Available in all TriHealth pediatric practices for patients aged 6 months and up.
- Children under 9 years receiving their 1st ever dose, must get a 2nd dose in the same season
- Flu season is typically October February.

#### **COVID Vaccine** (available year-round)

- Available in all TriHealth pediatric practices for patients aged 6 months and up.
- Children 6 months 4 years receiving their 1st ever dose, must get a 2nd dose 4-8 weeks after.

#### **RSV** (available October-March)

- Available in all TriHealth pediatric practices for newborns under 8 months born during or entering their 1<sup>st</sup> RSV season.
- Also available for infants and children 8-19 months who are at increased risk for severe RSV and entering their 2<sup>nd</sup> RSV season.

#### REMINDER - CALL IF YOU NEED TO CANCEL OR RESCHEDULE!

Out of courtesy to our providers and to ensure that we can provide care to patients needing to be seen, it is important that you notify us **at least 2 hours in advance** if you are unable to keep your scheduled appointment time. Notification within 2 hours or less will result in your appointment being marked as a no-show.


#### Same Day Scheduling Online!

TriHealth recently opened a Travel Vaccine & Preventative Care Clinic (10495 Montgomery Road, Suite 26) that offers personalized travel consultations, necessary vaccinations and comprehensive care plans based on your travel destinations. All required vaccines are in stock (i.e. Japanese encephalitis, yellow fever and more) and all major insurances are accepted.

#### How to Schedule:

- Patients 12 years and older: direct schedule via MyChart, at <u>TriHealth.com/Travel</u> or by calling 513 862-VACC (8222).
- Patients **5 11 years:** call 513 862-VACC to schedule (dependent on travel details).
