She loves plants, flowers- all things greenhouse! On March 6, 2023, Jamie suffered a stroke after going for a long walk while playing with her dogs in the yard. Her husband quickly recognized that something was wrong and relied on his son to quickly assess the "BEFAST stroke test" he had just been tested on in physiology class. She was taken to Good Samaritan where a thrombectomy was quickly performed to save her life. As she recalls the events of that day, she truly feels blessed that all the starts aligned, and that Divine intervention had a role in how quickly she was treated.
