Day Treatment Program

- This is an adult, mental health partial hospitalization program service that provides crisis stabilization and brief-to-intermediate term psychiatric care.
- Our structured, cognitive-behaviorally based treatment program benefits those who need a higher level of care that is not available in a typical outpatient setting and does not require inpatient hospitalization.

Who to Refer

Individuals who are normally high functioning but for various reasons, such as a loss or change in their life, are struggling at this time. The individual must be able to participate in a group therapy setting, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m to 2:30 p.m, with the average length of treatment being two weeks.

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Psychiatric Consults

- E-Consults
- Psychiatrists will provide timely support in managing psychiatrically ill patients, and will assess the appropriate level of care.
- For urgent concerns, in addition to an E-Consult, send a Voalte Message to the appropriate psychiatrist:
 - Consultative Psychiatrist Adult IBH
 - Consultative Psychiatrist Pediatric IBH

Alcohol and Drug Treatment Program

- Intensive Outpatient Program for substance use treatment including case management, individual counseling, medication assisted treatment and physician visits.

Collaborative Care Program

- This is a 13-week program, designed to assist patients with behavioral and lifestyle changes that can provide relief of depression symptoms, including sustaining depression medication adherence.
- Regular phone calls with a BH Care Manager who addresses patients' concerns, assists with goal setting, tracks progress, and provides tools for depressive symptom relief.
- Weekly review of cases by a Consulting Psychiatrist who partners with your Care Manager and Primary Care Provider to make medication suggestions and treatment adjustments. Additional screening may occur to evaluate progress.

Who to Refer

Adult patients diagnosed with moderate to severe depression with a Depression Screening Score, PHQ-9, of 15 or greater.

Outpatient BH Practice

Who to Refer

Complex cases with complicated psychiatric history. Patients who have failed medication intervention. Patients expected to return to Primary Care for medication refills when stable.
